Few objections /clarifications were received in CENTAC regarding the provisional allotment lists published on 09.04.2018.

As there are no errors, the lists have been finalized and published.

The joining time is till 20-04-2018 3.30 pm.

The candidates are requested to transfer the fee fixed and notified by the Govt. of Puducherry to CENTAC account through payment gateway on the CENTAC website. The fee collected by the CENTAC will be transferred to the Colleges concerned on a regular basis.

In case of any grievance or difficulty in admission process, the candidates are requested to submit their grievances during office hours to Dr. Nilamani (Mob-93454 54505, Grievances Officer, Directorate of Health and Family Welfare Services, Govt. of Puducherry.

The objections/suggestions have been examined and the gist of the same and the remarks of CENTAC are as below:

1. Whether the candidate not joining the allotted seat can participate in the second round?

Remarks: Yes.

Candidates can participate in second round without any limitation. After the joining time, the vacant seats will be notified and the interested candidates need to enter the preferences.

Notification No.MCI-18 (1) / 2018 – Med./100818 dt.05/04/2018 may please be referred to.

If a candidate is allotted a seat in 2nd and he/she joins, then the candidate is not eligible for the Mop up counselling. If the Candidate doesn't join in the seat allotted in the second ^{round} but wants to participate in Mop – up round, then the candidate has to deposit Rs.25,000 (half for SC/ST/OBC) for Government College and Rs.2,00,000/- for Self-financing College as ^{penal} fee. This amount will be forfeited if the student takes a seat during Mop-up session.

2. Why a candidate could not get a seat?

Remarks: CENTAC has done allotment based on RANK, reservation and preferences. As such if a candidate had not opted for a particular preference, the same would not be allotted. Even if the candidate had given a preference, the same would be allotted based on the availability of seat for his/her reservation.

3. How the vacant (management quota) seats in the Minority Colleges – PIMS and Sri Venkateswara Medical College will be filled?

Remarks: As per G.O. 10 dt.04.04.2018 of Health Secretariat Government of Puducherry, the management quota seats in the Minority Colleges are reserved for the Minority candidates of the U.T of Puducherry. If the seats are not filled even after second round, they will be converted in to Management Quota seats for candidates of Puducherry and remaining seats available, if any, will be filled up on All India basis during the Mop-up counseling.

The allotment is subject to the outcome of the Writ Petitions- W.P.13434 and 13435 of 2017 pending before Honourable High Court of Madras.
